BRIDGE TO NOWHERE never far back, gained along the four path on the last turn, chased, gained and under the whip bested SMOOTH TRANSITION for the win. SMOOTH TRANSITION contested the lead three across early, dueled after a half mile, kicked clear and then couldn't last. JITALIAN vied for the lead from between early, chased into the lane and then weakened. HOT ACT unhurried, gained along the rail on the last turn and flattened out. BACKSTAGE JOHNNIE vied for the lead along the rail early and gave way. PERSONAL SPENDER saved ground on the first turn, three path into the lane and tired.
