HENNESSY BEAUTY was well placed along the three path, gained into the stretch, began to drift in leaving the eighth pole, reached the leader in deep stretch, bumped hard with that one and under left handed pressure bested the latter for the win. STONERIDGE vied for the lead outside early, dueled on the turn, kicked loose some in midstretch, was hooked and then was bumped hard by the winner late while just missing. PANTSOFFTHEGROUND was unhurried along the rail, eased out and was going well late. VICTORIA POOL forced in at the start by PANTSOFFTHEGROUND, unhurried along the three path and then failed to threaten. CLASSY JET forced the issue early while saving ground and tired. WHEELY PINK two path on the turn and tired. DISCO DORA vied for the lead from between early, dueled along the two path bend and gave way. A claim of foul was lodged by the rider of STONERIDGE against the winner for interference in deep stretch, resulted in no change.
