COOL AND QUIET vied for the lead along the rail, battled inside to no avail but finished well. CRASHING COLBY was unhurried, gained along the three path, angled out and finished with interest. THE ONE THING was unhurried along the rail, eased out and made a late bid. MELVINDALE was well placed along the three path and weakened. WHY ARGUE was well placed along the two path into the lane and weakened. QUIETISM lagged back and then finished along the rail. ZIP ZONE lagged back along the two path, was not a factor. It was raining and with extreme wind from the south during the race.
