FOX RULES in hand along the three path, began to circle rivals along the three path into the lane, quickly took command and under pressure proved best. TEQUILA HERO jostled at the start, unhurried four wide up the backstretch, gained along the three path into the lane and finished well to clearly best the rest. COLLEEN'S SAILOR dueled for the lead early, cleared after a half mile, was collared from both sides midway on the final turn and then weakened but managed to stay clear for the show. BIGSHOTINTHENEWS was well placed along the rail, gained inside on the last turn to challenge for the lead, battled some and weakened. PLIME BLANK broke sluggishly, four path up the backstretch, two path rounding the final turn and tired. POWHATAN COUNTY saved ground, was outrun. SPORTSWRITER four wide into the backstretch, saved ground on the final bend and tired. PLEIADIAN vied for the lead along the rail early and gave way.
