BARCO never far back, gained along the three path on the turn, moved to challenge three deep in midstretch and under the whip got the money. HOLLY TIME vied for the lead from between, in tight at the three-eighths pole, checked, battled inside to the line and finished gamely. UNSUNG SONG vied for the lead from between, dueled into the lane, battled between in the lane, in tight late and checked. MR. JOLSON forced the issue four across early, dueled into the lane, battled in the drive and weakened. CAPTAIN NOAH four path on the turn and then failed to take part. STORM LEADER vied for the lead along the rail, in tight leaving the backstretch, checked and then tired. CODY GROVE checked at the start, saved ground, was outrun. A stewards inquiry was posted concerning the stretch run. Also a claim of foul was lodged by the rider of STORM LEADER against HOLLY TIME for interference at the three-eighths pole, was not allowed. Another claim of foul was lodged by the rider of UNSUNG SONG against the winner for interference late, was not allowed.
