DRY HUMOR contested the lead along the three path on the turn, battled to the line, got the nod and then was vanned off. NO ALIBI broke on top, vied for the lead off the rail, battled to the line while inside and just missed. CAMERON CANYON in tight at the five-eighths pole, checked, saved ground on the turn, eased out and finished with good energy. TANNERY TOWN was well placed along the three path, lodged a bid outside and weakened. GRANTIGGAN never far back, three path into the lane and then failed to gain. DANZIG CODE was unhurried along the two path, took the three path into the lane and then failed to take part. BACKDRAFTER four path on the turn and tired. WILD FUSION lagged back along the rail, was outrun. PRIME PROSPECT saved ground and tired. FASTPLUCKYLEE three path on the turn and tired. A claim of foul was lodged by the rider of CAMERON CANYON against NO ALIBI for interference at the five-eighths pole, was not allowed.
