QUICKEST TEMPER five wide up the backstretch, took the rail on the turn, angled out, gained and under the whip proved best. READUNDANT contested the lead along the two path, battled in the lane and just missed. BACKSTAGE PASS was unhurried, three path on the turn, angled out and rallied. ALLS IM SAYING was well placed, gained inside on the turn, challenged, battled and weakened. KALL ME SIG was unhurried, saved ground and then made a late bid. EL BAGRE vied for the lead early, three path on the turn and weakened. FIRSTBELLATHENKK two path on the turn and then failed to threaten. SHANE ROARS was well placed along the four path and tired.
