MR. WINDJAMMER was well placed along the three path, angled out some in the lane, quickly took command and under pressure proved the best. MARK'S ON ATTACK was unhurried five wide leaving the backstretch, six wide on the bend, angled out and finished with good energy. ONE LITTLE SECRET forced the issue along the three path, chased in the lane and weakened. DABADABADO tracked the leader along the four path on the turn, angled out and weakened. DADOWAY vied for the lead off the rail and tired. LOOKS LIKE MAGIC was well placed early, off the rail on the turn and weakened. CHEROKEE RICH lagged back off the rail, was not a factor.
