CURRENT AQUASITION never far back, gained four wide on the turn, responded and under the whip bested RKATSITELI for the win. RKATSITELI stalked along the two path, challenged at the top of the lane, kicked clear some and then finished gamely to just miss. DOUBLE CLAP was unhurried along the three path, gained outside in the lane and hung. RAFFIE'S FACTOR fractious loading in the gate, was well placed along the rail, in tight nearing the eighth pole, checked, angled out and weakened. WHOWHATHOW was well placed along the three path and tired. NO MORE TAXES was unhurried, checked at the half mile pole, three path into the lane and then failed to gain. CASPER saved ground and tired. POLITICALLY STEEL broke well, set the pace along the rail, was hooked at the top of the lane and tired.
