FUNNY TIDE slow to load in the gate, broke on top, vied for the lead early, took charge along the two path and under pressure proved best. THE OLE GEN tracked along the three path, chased, gained and finished well. SUPERTEN checked midway on the turn and finished with interest along the rail. CONFLICTED was well placed between foes along the four path into the lane and weakened. PAY THE JUDGE was unhurried along the two path and then failed to fire. HOWIE AND THE CAT five wide on the turn and tired. SUITE ERNIE B three path into the lane and tired. VAMEL three path on the turn and tired. LORD SIGMUNDO vied for the lead early, two path on the turn and tired. FLAG HANDLER saved ground, was done early.
