### Footnotes

SHADES OF SUGAR toyed with CEDAR ISLAND early, took charge along the two path on the turn and widened while never asked to win easily. LAMPBEAM was well placed tracking along the three path on the turn, chased to no avail but finished well. CRYSTAL MARKET was unhurried four wide into the turn, four wide entering the lane and was up for a share. GOLD LADY never far back along the rail and then failed to make a solid bid. EL PATRON ESPECIAL was well placed along the two path and weakened. CEDAR ISLAND vied for the lead along the rail, chased into the stretch and weakened. MISS RUBYCUBES was unhurried along four path on the turn and tired.
