THUNDER JAM contested the lead outside, shook loose nearing the quarter pole and then widened under the whip proving clearly the best. BETTER was well placed along the three path, tracked the winner into the lane but was clearly no match. BUY THE FOUR N TEN was well placed along the four path on the turn, lodged a bid outside in the lane and finished well. RANJIZ was unhurried along the four path into the lane and then finished with interest. LADY BUTTON EYES lagged far back, angled to the rail into the lane and then found her best stride late. WINLOC'S PILGRIM removed from the rail and the pace, lacked a rally. ACKYBACKY duled for the lead along the rail, chased into the lane, angled out and then tired. URSULA lagged back while five wide between foes into the lane, lacked a response. MISS ROYAL IBIS bobbled at the start and then was six wide throughout. DEBATE lagged back between foes on the turn and then failed to menace. LITTLE ABBY ANN saved ground, was done early. TACTICAL LADY five wide on the turn, was outrun.
