BEIJING HOUSE broke in the air, lagged back, circled foes into the lane, collared the leader in gear and then drew off to be a ridden out winner. REMARKABLE STORM stalked the leader along the three path leaving the backstretch, collared that one, took the advantage, was soon hooked and then was clearly no match. YUKON GOLD RUSH was well placed, four path on the last turn and then finished with interest. OEDIPUS O'NEAL was unhurried off the rail on the last turn and weakened. TEMORE was unhurried, saved ground on the turns and then lacked a rally. HEAD HEART HOOF set the pace to the lane and weakened. TWO DECADES five wide on the first turn, four path on the last turn and tired. BROCCO VALLEY was done early.
