ONTEORA'S TIGER broke sluggishly, gained along the three path, angled out, responded and outran BROOKLYN BOUND to the line. BROOKLYN BOUND was unhurried along the two path, gained, lacked room nearing the sixteenths pole while rallying and just missed. ENGINE COMPANY vied for the lead along the two path, battled inside and then missed in a good try. GRAY GALAXY gained, challenged at the top of the lane, battled and weakened. LUCKY US was unhurried along the rail and then lacked a rally. PAYING ATTENTION four path on the turn and then finished wide. ROAN ROOSTER was well placed along the four path and tired. FOXY MULDER forced the issue inside and tired. LIFE OF A TIGER broke in the air, two path into the lane, was not a factor. AWANA WIN lagged back, appeared in distress at the seven-sixteenths pole and was pulled up. .
