BRITE PROSPECTOR in hand along the three path, angled out in the lane, reached the lead in midstretch, drew off and then was under wraps late. MISS IVY HILTON set the pace off the rail, was hooked on the last turn, battled between foes in midstretch, chased, was no match but held on well to secure the place. COMET CROSSING lagged back along the rail, gained into the lane and then closed well late. RECOGNIZE ME was well placed, moved to challenge on the last turn, battled in the lane and then weakened. MICH'S CURE was never far back, in striking distance on the last turn and then weakened. CENTURION PRIDE was outrun. JAZPIANO chased early along the rail and tired. SOLETO showed nothing.
