### Footnotes

JET'S ROLE contested the lead from between foes to the lane, responded, shook free and under the whip proved best. PHILLY FRENZY vied for the lead along the rail to the lane, chased inside to no avail but held the place. PROWLING WOLF was unhurried along the rail, three path on the turn, angled out and finished with interest. WHIZBANG was unhurried along the three path, four path on the turn, angled out and finished well. CASH ME OUT was unhurried while five wide on the turn and then entered the lane six wide. JET G STAR vied for the lead three abreast to the lane and tired.
