KARAKORUM PATRIOT stalked the winner along the four path, lodged a bid, was no match but finished second best. WESNIAK was well placed, five wide on the turn and finished with interest. WHEEL'N AND ABLE never far back, entered the stretch five wide and hung. KWIK BULLET was unhurried along the three path, angled wide and lacked a rally. CASH ME OUT was unhurried and then lacked a closing bid. POLISH BRIAR five wide into the lane, was not a threat. RED'S RED was well placed along the three path and tired. ETERNAL GLITTER saved ground, was outrun. GOOD VERSUS BAD showed little. PETE SHURE six wide on the turn and then finished wide. BIG OUT saved ground and tired.
