CAPTAIN NOAH set the pace, responded when roused and was ridden out to the line. BISTRO SOIREE was well placed along the rail, altered course late and finished well. I QUIT stalked the winner, lodged a bid and weakened late. ALLABOUTMACK was unhurried along the three path and finished with interest. AYOUNG MINISTER off the rail on the turn, lodged a bid and hung. MILLIROCK three path on the bend and failed to respond. LION ON THE RUN checked early, five wide into the lane and hung. RITTSKI was outrun. DIVORCED DECISION was well placed five wide on the turn and tired. MAGIC CARD TRICK saved ground and tired. MR. PETERSSON an early factor along the rail and tired.
