AL'S DEPUTY was unhurried along the rail, angled out to the three path into the lane, was set down, gained to challenge briefly and drove clear. HAYA'S BOY tracked, dueled at the top of the lane, battled to no avail but finished well. PRO'S PAL sprinted clear, set the pace off the rail, was hooked at the top of the lane, battled and weakened. ELSAROARIN was unhurried along the three path and made a late bid. SIX FLINGS two path on the turn and then failed to fire. TOO TOUGH PETE gained along the four path on the turn and weakened. RHAEBUS two path on the turn and weakened. NO MINE jostled at the start, saved ground and weakened. DAHLGREN CHAPEL four path into the lane and then failed to take part. PASSING TIME three path on the corner and tired.
