COLOGNY tracked the pacesetters along the four path, moved to challenge for the lead nearing the quarter pole, battled briefly, took command and then was under steady pressure to turn back TRAVELATOR for the win. TRAVELATOR was well placed off the rail, eased out into the lane, launched a bid and finished with good energy to clearly best the rest. SERENITY'S SMILE was unhurried along the three path, gained ground into the lane, lodged a bid from between foes in midstretch and finished well. STORM ON THE LAKE set the pace off the rail while pressed, battled nearing the quarter pole, chased in the lane and weakened. PERTY NUMBER lagged back, three path on the turn, angled in the lane and then lacked a solid bid. RUBY'S ROCKET saved ground on the turn, was not a factor. CARRIE'S TURN forced the issue along the three path early and faded. WE'LL SEA YA five wide on the turn, was not a threat. BETTER between foes leaving the backstretch along the four path and tired.
