Footnotes

CANDOBLE was unhurried five wide into the backstretch, gained along the three path on the last turn, angled in for the drive and ran on by GRANTIGGAN for the win. GRANTIGGAN broke well, set the pace while pressed three from the rail up the backstretch, cleared nearing the eighth pole, ducked out at the sixteenth pole and then could not recover. MR REESE checked at the fifteen-sixteenths pole, stalked five wide up the backstretch, challenged four wide at the top of the lane and then finished well out in the strip. BELL FLOP forced the issue early along the rail, saved ground on the last turn and then passed faders. L' WAR jostled at the start, well placed six wide up the backstretch, five wide into the lane and tired. EL MOJETO was unhurried, saved ground on the last turn and tired. WILD FUSION lagged back, saved ground and tired. TOUCHNLUCK checked at the fifteen-sixteenths pole, well placed three off the rail up the backstretch and tired. SILVER GLADIATOR checked at the fifteen-sixteenth pole, saved ground on the corners and tired.
