SPA PRINCESS was well placed, gained along the four path on the bend, challenged the leaders at the top of the lane, battled, responded and drew off. WARM COUNTRY slow to load in the gate, bobbed at the start, five wide up the backstretch, five wide on the turn and then closed well to earn the place. QUEENIE'S BABY vied for the lead along the three path, battled between into the lane then weakened late. SKIP AWAY BELLE was well placed along the rail, lacked room at the top of the lane, checked and then made a bid inside. CHARMING OFFICER was unhurried along the three path and then lacked a solid bid. TO KIL FOR lagged back and then failed to menace. CELTIC KETTLE vied for the lead off the rail and gave way.
