BLUE DIABLO vied for the lead from between three deep, battled in the lane, responded and got the job done. COSMO BABE four across early, five wide into the lane, lodged a bid and finished well. NOT EASY was unhurried along the two path, angled out and was along for a share. CHARMING OFFICER was well placed along the three path, angled in some in the lane and weakened. EAGER FOR ACTION was unhurried along the four path and then made a mild bid. MYWIFNOSEVRYTHING vied for the lead along the rail early, in tight nearing the three-eighths pole, checked and weakened. PETAL MEADOW vied for the lead along the two path to the lane and tired. RIZZI'S TWIST lagged far back, was outrun. KEEP RUNNING five wide on the turn and tired.
