BRISTOL HARBOUR vied for the lead early, between foes entering the lane along the two path, lost the whip when asked in midstretch and then still managed to earn a share. ITS BUSINESS TIME never far back, entered the lane along the three path and weakened. PURA P T slow to settle, saved ground and then was going well late. SUPREME SERENE vied for the lead along the rail and faded. TROOP SUPPORT was well placed, challenged four across at the top of the lane and faded.
