ROCKINANRACIN never far back along the three path, two path midway on the turn, checked between rivals at the top of the lane, split foes in midstretch to take the lead and under the whip proved best. HUDSON HEIGHTS gained along the two path on the turn, angled out and rallied. AGAIN ELEVEN never far back, four path on the turn, gained, battled and weakened. BRIGHTROCK four across on the pace early, four path into the lane and weakened. TANNHAUSER broke sluggishly, saved ground on the turn and then lacked a rally. WABASH RIVER vied for the from between, battled inside and weakened. END OF THE GULCH vied for the lead from between three deep early, three across into the lane and weakened. STORMZAPPER five wide on the turn and then finished wide. STRIKE JET vied for the lead along the rail and gave way.
