WISEMAN'S FATE broke well, vied for the lead along the two path, kicked loose and under pressure proved best. MILLIONS IN MOTION vied for the lead along the rail to the lane, chased and finished well. BRIER was well placed along the rail, angled out to the three path into the lane, lodged a bid and hung. MISS BRASS BONANZA unhurried, angled out four wide into the lane and weakened. PENNY PULPIT was well placed along the three path to the lane and weakened. HELLACIOUS CAT saved ground and tired. JOYOUS ROAR broke slow spotting the field three lengths, five wide trip and tired.
