TURNPIKE TOKEN never far back off the rail, angled wide in the lane and rallied. VITAL ARGUMENT vied for the lead along the three path, battled between in the drive and weakened. NO DETOUR vied for the lead off the rail to the eighth pole and weakened. THUNDER MINISTER lagged back, three path on the turn and then lacked a rally. NEW YORK TOUGH four path on the turn and tired.
