IS IT TUESDAY YET was unhurried along the two path, angled out and rallied for the win. EDUBAIYAH WAY was well placed along the three path, challenged in midstretch, took the lead and then just missed. POLICY WONK saved ground, altered out leaving the backstretch for room, gained along the two path and then hung in the late stages. SENEGAL lagged far back, angled out in the lane and made a late bid. HAWK MOUNTAIN forced the issue along the rail, challenged in midstretch and weakened. SECRETS ONLY fractious just as the gates opened, reared spotting the field three lengths, four path on the turn and weakened. RADICAL STORM broke well, set the pace while pressed along the three path, shook clear some at the top of the lane, was hooked and gave way.
