KARL'S RUNNER was never far back along the rail, lodged a bid inside, collared the leader late and bested that one for the win. ROBYN REGAL broke well, vied for the lead off the rail, shook loose some in the lane, battled late and finished gamely. TACTICAL PRINCE lagged back, gained ground along the three path on the turn, angled out for the drive and finished with good energy. RAILROAD MILLS vied for the lead from between foes early, four path on the turn and then finished with interest. BAY GUARD was unhurried along the four path on the turn, angled out for the drive and made a late bid. SUNSHINE NUMBERS was well placed along the three path on the turn while in hand, asked into the lane and came up empty. LORD BUCK lagged back and then failed to menace. ADMIRALINTHENAVY five wide on the turn and tired. EMBRACE REALITY was outrun. PROMISING STORM vied for the lead while three abreast early and tired.
