EAGER FOR ACTION tracked the leaders along the four path, responded while four across in midstretch and bested SPUNKY for the win. SPUNKY vied for the lead, battled with the winner and finished gamely. FLORIDA QUAKER broke well, vied for the lead along the two path and then weakened leaving the eighth pole. SEVENTEEN LOVE never far back, angled to the rail for the drive and hung. DAVID'S FLAME was unhurried along the four path, angled out and then lacked a rally. BLACK VELVET BAND five wide on the turn and then finished wide. SERIOUS SONG an early factor five wide on the bend and tired. GOGO LILLY saved ground, was outrun.
