VISIBLE SONG set the pace off the rail while pressed, battled in the lane, drifted out some late and under strong handling got the nod. TOP ENCOUNTER forced the issue along the three path, matched strides in the lane, was forced out some late by the winner while finishing gamely to just miss. FLEETENGLY devoid of early speed along the four path, gained ground into the lane, split foes in deep stretch and was going well late. SWORD OF IRON was never far back while five wide on the turn, lodged a bid in the lane and hung. DARSELA was well placed along the rail, chased the leaders in the lane and weakened. PROSPECTFORME six wide on the turn, was not a factor. LAITEE LEGS saved ground, was outrun. OATKA LITTLE GIRL four path on the turn, tired. SCARLET TREASURE three path while between foes on the turn and tired. GIRL FROM HARVARD an early along the three path and tired. A claim of foul was lodged by the rider of TOP ENCOUNTER against the winner for interference in deep stretch, resulted in no change in the order of finish.
