NOMOREMRNICEGUY forced the issue, took charge in upper stretch and then was whipped to the wire for the win. MR. WINDJAMMER never far back, four path on the turn, angled out, loomed a threat leaving the eighth pole and then hung. LIFE RUNNER set the pace while pressed along the rail and weakened. MIKE'S ALWAYS FAIR was well placed along the three path on the turn, angled out and weakened. RULE SEVENTY SIX was well placed saving ground and weakened. MR TOUGH ENOUGH lagged back, was outrun. STORM'S A COMIN five wide up the backstretch, three path on the turn and tired.
