MR. HOPPS well placed and outside, challenged for and gained a short lead through the second turn, then held through the lane under steady pressure. JESSIE TOWTRUCK allowed to settle, gained a striking position on the two path through the turn, came through and angled in in the stretch, then lacked the needed late kick. STAY HIGH STANLEY well back, moved up three wide through the second turn, fanned widest into the stretch and got up for the show, while running evenly late. ANDROMEDAS DESTINY sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, stayed on when challenged through the second turn, then weakened in the drive. QUAD ACES well placed and inside, gained position through the second turn and faded in the drive. ADRIATIC allowed to settle, moved up four wide through the second turn and had no stretch rally. DIGBY B was a brief factor and was eased over the wire.
