JOHN'S SHARP HUMOR tracked, vied along the lead along the three path on into the lane, battled but was no match late. BAD BOY BUBBY was well placed, two path into the lane and hung. BRENDAN'S WARRIOR was unhurried, saved ground, eased out and made a mild bid. WISEMAN JACK four path on the turn and finished evenly. ONTOTHENEXTONE was well placed along the three path and tired. JILLUKE broke slow, four path on the turn and then finished wide. NEW YORK TOUGH set the pace early, dueled along the rail into the lane, battled and faded.
