STORMING RENEE broke alertly, set the pace along the rail, was clear with a furlong to go and then was all out to narrowly turn back BURN BABY BURN for the win. BURN BABY BURN unhurried early, gained ground along the four path on the turn while between foes, angled out some for the drive, responded gamely when roused and closed determinedly to just miss. BETTER saved ground, took up sharply at the three-eighth pole, angled out in the lane and rallied. BETWIX AND BETWEEN lagged back, gained ground five wide on the final turn, lodged a bid in the lane and finished well. SIS ROSE lagged back, between foes at the three-eighth pole, angled out for the drive and made a late bid. SKIP N' RUN chased on the turn, lodged a bid in the lane and then hung. BELIEVEHER chased early, dropped back leaving the backstretch, angled to the rail on the turn and then weakened. CANDYLICIOUS lagged back, was forced seven wide at the quarter pole and then failed to menace. MISS IVY HILTON chased early, was forced six wide at the quarter pole and then tired. SHEERS SANDY forwardly placed, bore out on the turn forcing rivals wide and then gave way.
