**Footnotes**

WATRALS STRIKE GO rated up the backstretch, gained ground on the final bend, split foes into the lane, rallied to reach the leaders with a furlong to go and under pressure proved best. FAIRYTALE ROMANCE was unhurried up the backstretch, gained some on the last turn while between foes, angled out in the lane and rallied to earn the place. DOLCELINA was well placed in hand, between foes leaving the backstretch, moved to challenge into the lane, battled and then just missed the place. JOANIE B. vied for the lead along the three path, battled between foes in midstretch and then weakened. SHINE FOR lagged back along the rail and then lacked a solid bid. IRISH GINGER saved ground while well placed on the last turn and weakened. SUMAC SUE forced the issue while three abreast along the four path up the backstretch and then tired. SURGEON forced the issue along the rail, battled into the lane and then gave way. BROOMVILLE five wide on the last turn and tired.
