ACTALITTLE vied for the lead off the rail, shook loose in the lane and then widened while kept to the whip. NEED A PHONE was unhurried along the three path, lodged a bid into the lane, split foes in midstretch and finished with good energy. QUITE BY CHANCE lagged back, six wide on the turn, angled out in the lane and rallied. HEATHER HURRY UP was unhurried while five wide on the turn, asked and made a mild bid. ROSE'S ECHO was well placed along the rail and tired. COLD SPRING lagged back along the three path, was not a threat. CHATELIAN vied for the lead along the three path to the lane and gave way. EAGLE CAT was outrun. COO COLD BIRD saved ground to no avail. CARR QUEEN was well placed off the rail, eased out in the lane, lacked room, stumbled and then took up sharply at the sixteenth pole.
