Footnotes

BELLAMY never far back and off the rail, moved up three and four wide through the turn, angled out slightly in the stretch for clear racing room, made a steady gain and got up in the final strides. MOM PROOF allowed to settle, moved up three wide through the turn, bid between rivals into the stretch, closed well to gain a late lead and was outfinished. MORNING HERALD allowed to settle, moved up four wide through the turn, fanned widest into the stretch, made a steady gain and missed. EL GRANDE PATRON chased the early pace off the rail, moved up to challenge through the turn, drifted out slightly into the stretch, bumped SECOND AND ONE while dueling with that one, continued to drift out through the lane and weakened. SECOND AND ONE well placed and four wide, moved up to challenge on that path through the turn, dueled with and was bumped by EL GRANDE PATRON through the lane and weakened the final furlong. WISTFUL WILDCAT set a pressure pace off the rail and faded the final furlong. LORD SIGMUNDO well placed and inside, had no stretch rally.
