DEMOCRAT vied for the lead from between two deep, kicked clear when roused and then was ridden out. CHARING CROSS was well placed six wide up the backstretch, challenged three across at the top of the lane, chased to no avail and then finished well. IT'S MAGICAL was unhurried along the rail on the turn, eased out and finished with interest. WESTERN JET vied for the lead along the rail and weakened. FIRSTFROMTHEBOX gained four wide into the lane and weakened. MERCURY RISING two path on the turn, was not a factor. SUNDAY DREAMER vied for the lead from between along the three path and tired. EARLY RESPONSE three path on the turn, was done early.
