JEMARU well placed and inside, moved up inside through the turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, then angled out and got up in the final stride. NEW YORK TOUGH sprinted to a clear lead quickly, increased his margin and was outfinished. BLUESPOWERHOUSE stalked the pace on the outside, gained a striking position three wide through the turn, bid on that path into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. HI HO SILVERMAN well placed and outside, gained position through the turn, came four wide to bid, then lost ground through the lane while holding a share. ITS BUSINESS TIME steadily lost ground. BUCKY improved his position. BRENDAN'S WARRIOR broke awkwardly and showed little. LOS CAOBOS was no factor.
