CARR QUEEN chased early, moved to challenge into the lane from between foes, battled briefly but was clearly no match. WITH SWEET ANNIE five wide on the turn, lodged a bid in the drive and found her best stride too late. LITTLE SURFER lagged back along the rail on the turn, swung out for the drive and made a late bid. ACKYBACKY was well placed early along the four path, lodged a bid in the lane and hung. MISSION PROBABLE set the pace, battled on the turn along the rail and then weakened. KARA JEAN six wide trip. HANNA'S K C saved ground, was not a factor.
