SUNDAY DREAMER was well placed along the four path, chased and weakened. FIRSTFROMTHEBOX was unhurried, four path on the turn and then lacked a rally. DEWANNA BRUSHON ME forced the issue inside and tired. TIMEOUTFORTHEJUDGE four path into the lane, was not a factor. OTTER ISLAND was well placed along the three path to the lane and tired.
