CROMWELL ALLEY never far back, gained along the two path into the lane, loomed a threat with a furlong to go and hung. BEDROCK BLUES was unhurried, two path on the corners and then lacked a rally. SARATOGA COWBOY bobbled at the start, tracked, saved ground on the last turn, challenged some and weakened. SIR JUSTIN broke sluggishly and then was outrun. STAY ALITTLE WHILE three path on the turns and weakened. ROAR TIGER ROAR three path on the turns and tired.
