FEARLESS BUZZ was unhurried along the two path, eased out and made a late bid. PATRICKS CALL broke sluggishly, was well placed along the rail and tired. COMMUNICATOR vied for the lead along the rail and gave way. TEN BELLS was well placed along the three path and tired. EASY SPUR lagged back along the three path, was outrun. STAY ALITTLE WHILE four path into the lane and tired.
