YONNI was well placed along the rail, slipped inside to take over and under the whip outran SAICHI SWEEPIN to the wire. SAICHI SWEEPIN was well placed, gained along the four path into the lane and rallied wide. STARBUCKETS was unhurried along the two path, eased out some and rallied. WINK AND FLY broke slow, rushed to the lead, set the pace along the two path, was hooked and weakened. SHEZA SWEET LEMON tracked along the three path and weakened. COPIOUS NOTES an early factor up the backstretch, two path on the bend and weakened. BANDIT LADY there path on the turn, was not a factor. YES I CAN CAN trailed along the two path without mishap.
