WINTERLILY tracked up the backstretch, took up sharply to avoid a pulled up foe at the three-eighths pole, challenged at the top of the lane, responded and proved best. LUNAR CHIP was unhurried early, gained along the rail on the last turn, lodged a bid and finished with good energy to just miss. WE LOVE OUR KIDS tracked, took up sharply to avoid the pulled up foe at the three-eighths pole, gained the lead in midstretch and finished gamely to just miss. BROOKE HALEY was unhurried, took up sharply to avoid the pulled up foe at the three-eighths pole and then rallied. NANTASKET well placed, took up sharply to avoid the pulled up foe at the three-eighths pole and then made a mild bid. WINLOC'S HAIL MARY was unhurried, took up sharply to avoid the pulled up foe at the three-eighths pole and then failed to menace. MYSTERIOUS KEY vied for the lead off the rail and tired. EXPENSIVE LOVER lagged back, tired. WINLOC'S IRENE vied for the lead, pulled up at the three-eighths pole and then was vanned off. A stewards inquiry was posted concerning WINLOC'S IRENE pulling up, resulted in no change.
