LADY BUTTON EYES tracked the leader leaving the backstretch along the four path, moved to challenge for the advantage in midstretch, responded to the whip and then drew off. HAPPY MERMAID broke sharply, set the pace off the rail, was hooked in midstretch, battled briefly but was clearly no match. TONY'S MELISSA was never far back along the four path on the last turn, chased the leader in midstretch but was no match for the top two finishers. BAUGHER was unhurried along the four path, angled out some in the lane and then made a mild gain. SAMS HALO saved ground, in striking distance into the lane and then finished evenly. URSULA lagged back along the rail and then lacked a rally. HEAVENLY ARC was outrun. TACTICAL LADY showed little. ANA chased the leader along the rail and tired. DEBATE six wide on the first turn, five wide on the last turn and tired.
