DOUBLE THE DEBT in hand along the three path, gained ground on the turn along the four path, reached contention in midstretch, responded to the whip and drove clear for the win. SHESASTONECOLDFOX broke sharply, drifted in bothering rivals at the eleven-sixteenth pole, dueled for the lead along the three path, shook loose some into the lane, was hooked in midstretch, battled some and then drifted in late while clear to secure the place. BELONGS TO MONY was bumped hard at the eleven-sixteenth by CARRIE'S TURN, angled to the rail on the turn, angled out in the lane and then rallied. J AND B'S NU IMAGE was never far back, gained ground when asked on the turn along the three path, chased the leader in the lane and then checked briefly late when SHESASTONECOLDFOX drifted in. ALLEY BALL devoid of early speed and then angled out widest of all in the lane. CAM A RETTA saved ground on the turn, failed to menace. SOLI DARY was well placed to the lane along the rail and tired. CAMIONETTE was bumped at the eleven-sixteenth pole and then could not keep up. CARRIE'S TURN was bothered by SHESASTONECOLDFOX at the eleven-sixteenth pole, bumped hard with CAMIONETTE, rushed out and dueled for the lead along the rail and then tired. A claim of foul was lodged by the rider of BELONGS TO MONY against SHESASTONECOLDFOX for interference at the eleven-sixteenth pole, resulted in no change. Also a claim of foul was lodged by the ride of J AND B'S NU IMAGE for interference at the sixteenth pole, also resulted in no change in the order of finish.
