SMOKEM'S CHARM set the pace on the inside, gained a clear lead into the turn, then dueled with WHY ARGUE through the lane and edged ahead late. WHY ARGUE stalked the pace on the outside, moved up to bid outside and duel through the lane and was outfinished. DANCER'S ROCKET well placed and outside, moved up three wide through the turn, fanned four wide to bid and ran evenly in the lane. KID KAOS never far back, moved up three and four wide through the turn, fanned widest into the stretch and lost ground. BUBBA'S CHOICE ran evenly. DOUBLE WHAM was never involved.
