TAKE THE PRESS broke slow, two path on the turn, angled out and found her best late. GRAND SAVANNA vied for the lead along the rail and gave way. QUEEN BE ONTRACK broke slow, three path on the turn and then failed to take part. RUN THRU THE WOODS two path on the turn and tired.
